

# **Implementation Rules for the Ownership Review of Intellectual Property Rights for Research and Development Achievements at Chung Yuan Christian University**

- Article 1. (Basis)  
These rules are established in accordance with Article 20 of the "Management Regulations for Research and Development Achievements and Technology Transfers at Chung Yuan Christian University".
- Article 2. (Reviewing Assignment)  
For non-government commissioned industry-academia collaboration project applications, the ownership of research and development achievements shall be reviewed in accordance with Article 20 of the "Management Regulations for Research and Development Achievements and Technology Transfers at Chung Yuan Christian University". The project leader shall provide explanations and submit relevant documents to the Office of Industry-Academia Collaboration (hereinafter referred to as "the Office") for review.  
Upon receiving the aforementioned documents, the Office shall submit them to a committee consisting of three or more members of the Patent and Technology Transfer Benefits Committee for review. The review process shall be primarily conducted in writing, with the possibility of holding a meeting if necessary.
- Article 3. (Review Principles)  
The following factors shall be taken into consideration during the review:  
  1. Resources invested in by both parties, collaboration methods, rights and obligations, anticipated output results, and research and development contribution ratios.
  2. The ownership, applications, and cost-sharing methods for patents or other intellectual property rights.
  3. Utilization methods and distribution of benefits for project achievements.
  4. Other relevant matters.  
The review committee shall review the application and, after consolidating the review opinions and results, notify the project leader through the Office.
- Article 4. (Appeal)  
The project leader may submit an appeal to the Office within two weeks from the date of receiving the review results. The appeal shall be discussed by the Patent and Technology Transfer Benefits Committee upon submission to determine whether it will be accepted.
- Article 5. (Submission)  
If the project leader disagrees with the appeal result, the Office shall submit it to the President for final decision.
- Article 6. (Effective Date and Implementation)  
The Rules are passed by the Patent and Technology Transfer Benefits Committee meeting, and shall be promulgated and enforced by the Principal. The same shall apply where the Rules are amended.
